Mosaic techniques with Maria Amburn

Saturday, October 12, 2019. How to use thinset mortar to create a mosaic project. The class begins at 10 a.m. at the Sidney Art Gallery; the cost will be \$25; and there is a 10-student limit to the class size. Everything provided except lunch.

- **The Base:** We will provide wooden panels for the foundation, but you may choose another base, which you will need to bring to class. I hope we can finish the project in one class, so think about the size of your base; think smaller rather than larger.

- **Supplies:** We will be using broken pottery and mirror pieces for the background, which will be provided. You may bring any tchotchkes you have collected, like beads, old costume jewelry, or any found object that will fit the size of your project. These bits and pieces will be imbedded into your mosaic design. Go to yard sales and thrift stores to look for treasures that catch your attention. The items you pick and choose for yourself will give more meaning to your creation.

- **The Goal:** I want you to have fun making this mosaic piece. There is no right or wrong way to design your project. It is random; it is **your** eye that needs pleasing, no one else's.
