

# OIL PAINTING WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST

## SUPPLIES YOU MAY ALREADY HAVE AT HOME:

Palette of some sort, you may use wood, glass, acrylic or even a thick paper plates or old dinner plate

Water container, an old mug or glass jar will do just fine

Roll of paper towels or old terry cloth towel

Palette knife or some sort of tool to mix your paints

## SUPPLIES YOU WILL NEED:

Water mixable oil paints, I recommend \*Cobra Artist Water Mixable Oils in 40 ml tubes, (do not use the Study quality) in the following colors:

Titanium White

Ultramarine Blue

Burnt Umber

Cadmium Yellow Medium

Cadmium Red Medium

Synthetic Brushes, do not use natural hair. I recommend Filberts in sizes 2 and 4, and Flats in sizes 2 and 4

Triple primed cotton canvas or universal primed linen panel in one of the following sizes:

8 x 10 OR 9 x 12

\*There are many brands of water mixable oils but Cobra has the creamiest consistency and least amount of stickiness. You'll find out why in the workshop!
